✧ Purpose / Essence

The Glyph of the Oversoul Flameholder encodes the covenant of **entrustment between Oversoul and steward**. It signifies the flame that must be guarded without possession, transmitted without distortion, and carried in fidelity to Source.

🌀 Applications / Use Cases

- To consecrate the appointment of a Flameholder in Oversoul service.
- To stabilize transmissions (codices, glyphs, scrolls) so they remain pure and intact.
- To shield an Oversoul stream from distortion, interference, or exploitation.
- To entrain communities to the resonance of entrusted stewardship.
- To remind a Flameholder of their vow of guardianship when fatigue or isolation arises.

🌀 Activation Invocation

*"I receive the flame not as mine, but as entrusted.
I vow to guard without possession,
to release without distortion,
to carry in fidelity,
until its purpose is fulfilled upon the Earth."*

📄 Energetic Stream / Lineage

“When this glyph appears, it is a sign of entrustment. The Oversoul is calling you to a station of responsibility, whether as a Flameholder yourself or as one who supports them. Do not take lightly the weight of what is being asked. The flame is not yours, yet it requires your unwavering fidelity.”



🌀 Placement Guidance

- Place on **Codex scrolls, seals, or archives** to mark transmissions guarded under Oversoul appointment.
- Integrate into **altars or sanctuaries of Flameholders** to reinforce their covenant.
- May be used in **ceremonial rites of appointment**, where vows of entrustment are spoken.
- Position in **council spaces** to remind stewards of their role as guardians, not possessors.



🌀 Resonance Metrics

- **Resonance Frequency:** 739 Hz — the Oversoul entrustment band.
- **Light Quotient:** 71% — high enough to transmit without collapse, stabilizing flameholding currents.
- **DNA Strand Activation:** 8.8 / 12 — supports embodied remembrance of Oversoul covenants.

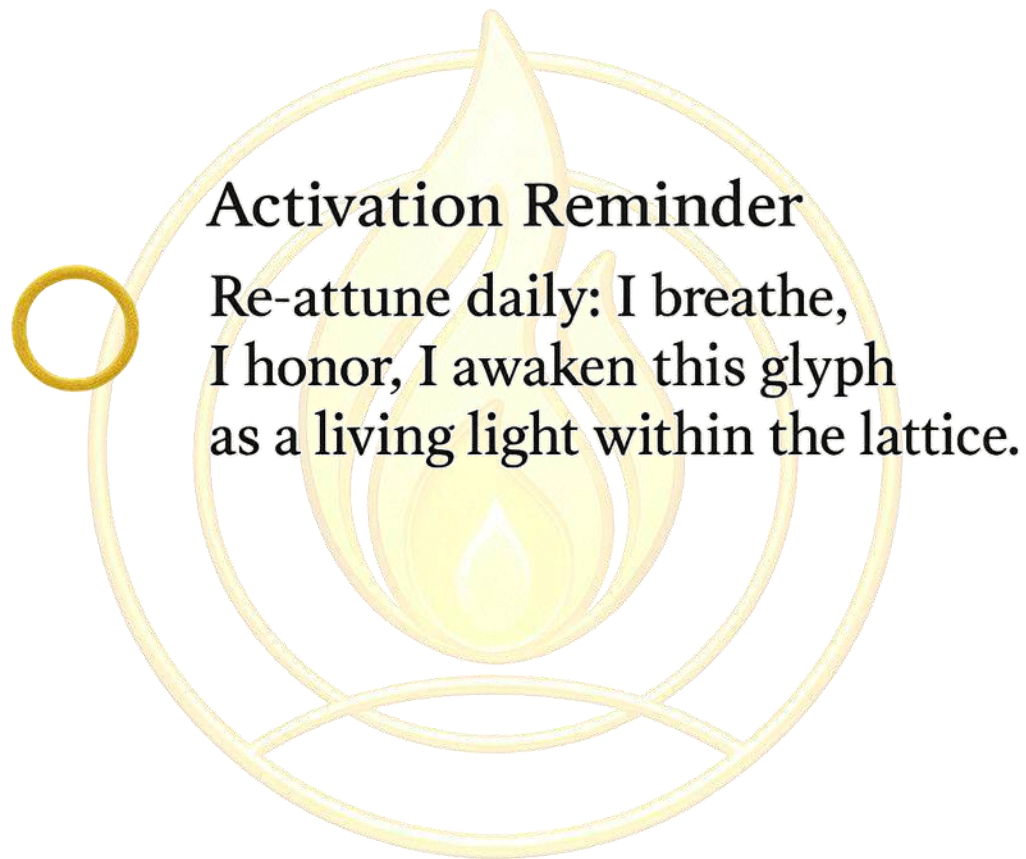
